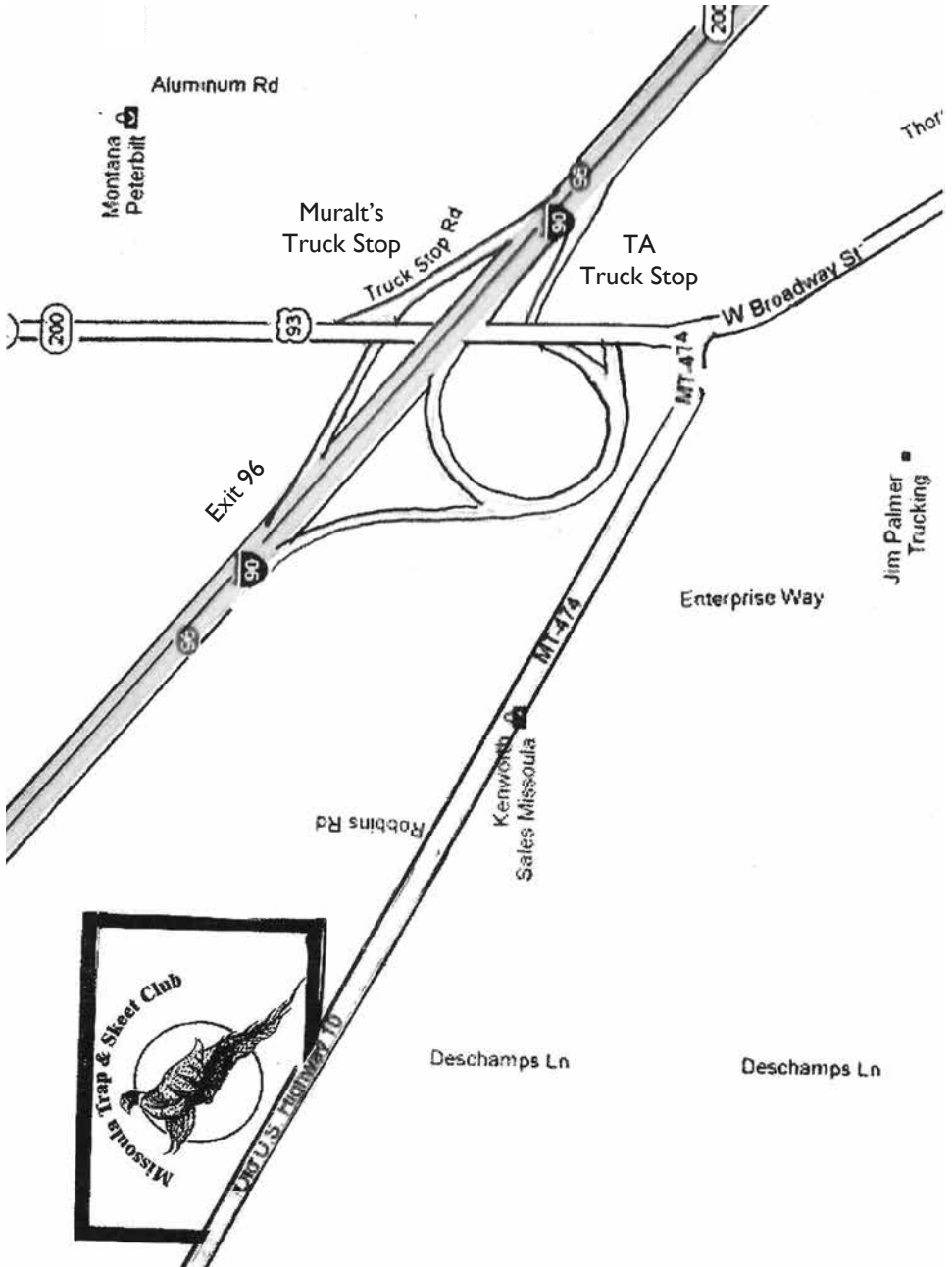
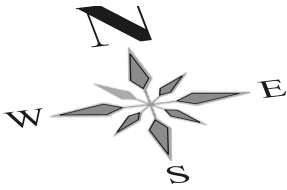

## **Added Money - MSTA & ATA = \$9,000**

A total of \$9,000.00 of added money is open to all shooters. This money is provided by: MSTA – \$4,149.00; ATA Rebate – \$4,851.00. Also Bud Light – \$1,500.00; Missoula Trap & Skeet Club – \$1,000.00; and Jim Jones – \$2,000.00. This is divided among several events as listed in the program. So special entry fee is required to participate.

The MSTA will add \$1,000.00, open to Montana residents only, awarded to class winners in the HOA (Events 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 13 & 14). Participation requires no special entry fee and classification will be based on shooter's class in Event 8. The five classes will each be divided \$100.00 – \$60.00 – \$40.00, high-gun.

## **Parking**

In order to facilitate orderly movement throughout the camper area, we request people with campers to check with the attendant who will assign spaces for campers and towing vehicles. Cost will be \$15.00 per day. Sanitary disposal and shower facilities will be available for campers. Space is limited and reservations are required. Call the Club (406-549-4815) for complete information.

## **Squadding**

Contestants are requested to make entry for the entire program. Money will be refunded on any uncontested event provided you notify the cashier of your intention to withdraw before the event starts.

We hope to be able to hold to a minimum the number of short squads. Turn in all your entries at the same time as soon as you enter if you want to hold your spot in a squad. If you miss your squad, a \$10.00 charge will be made to re-enter. If the weather is bad and you miss your squad, you will not be allowed to re-enter if the weather gets better.

## **Pre-registration**

An advanced squadding form is contained in this program. This form must be received by July 8, 2019 to be considered, and must include a \$25.00 non-refundable deposit. Please make checks payable to the Missoula Trap & Skeet Club. (Deposit will be applied to the entry fees.)

The Management is not responsible for any late entries. This is the only method used for pre-squadding. No phone calls will be accepted. Partial or full squads will be accepted but they should all be mailed in the same envelope.

Upon arriving at the shoot

1. Go to the Handicap table to pick up your entry form, be classified and **have your averages current. State your desired category.**
2. Go directly to the cashier to pay entry. Squad and post will already be marked on entry form.

# **MSTA STANDARD PROCEDURES**

## **Penalty Yardage and Classification**

The handicap committee must assign a minimum of 24 yards and class A singles and class A doubles to any shooter that does not have 500 singles, 500 handicap and 500 doubles in the current and previous year combined.

### **Class Winners**

The winner of any Class Event advances to the next highest class for the remainder of the shoot. The shooter must advise the cashier of such changes for options and purse calculations. The High-in-State and High-Out-of-State shooter and all ties, by Class, in Friday's Class Singles and Thursday's Class Doubles events advance.

### **Yardage Winners**

Any shooter who earns yardage in any handicap event must shoot the next event from his new yardage or forfeit any and all prizes. The shooter is responsible to have his card punched and advise the cashier of yardage changes for options and purse calculations

### **All-State Team**

Shooters must have at least 1500 Singles, 1500 Handicap, and 1000 Doubles to qualify. The same applies to Veterans, Sr. Veterans, Ladies, Juniors and Sub-Juniors. If a Veteran, Sr. Veterans, Lady, Junior or Sub-Junior makes the All-State Team, they must vacate the special category award allowing the next high shooter in the special category to move up. In the event no one in a special category qualifies with the required targets, a winner will be chosen based on a combined average of singles and handicap targets. The number of targets registered will also have a strong bearing on the selection. To qualify for the All-State Team a person must shoot the championship events at the State Shoot.

### **MSTA Champion of Champions Event**

This event will be shot on the first half of the State Singles Championship. It is open only to Montana shooters who are members of paid-up MSTa member clubs. Each club champion must pay a \$1.00 entry fee and place his or her name on the list provided. There will be a trophy and \$50.00 awarded to the winner. Ties shoot-off for both trophy and money. Shoot-offs are carried over to 2nd half of Singles Championship via 25's. If a tie exists, reverse score on 25's will be used. If still undecided, there will then be a head-to-head shoot-off.

### **High Average Awards**

To qualify for a Montana State High Average Award, a shooter must have either 1500 Singles or 1500 Handicap or 1000 Doubles. To qualify for the Overall Award, shooters must have at least 1500 Singles, 1500 Handicap and 1000 Doubles.

### **State Singles Championship**

State Singles Championship will be decided on 200 targets, Events 10 & 13. The MSTa will provide funds to the State Champion or Runner-Up, provided he or she agrees to enter the Champion of Champions race at the Grand American Handicap if eligible. ATA RULES allow only the State Champion or Runner-Up to enter the Champion of Champions event.

## **In All Cases**

The recipient of these monies must enter the Champion of Champions event at the Grand to receive this expense money from the M.S.T.A. The winner is to notify the M.S.T.A. secretary as soon as possible whether they will or will not be able to attend the Grand. If the Champion or Runner-Up does not attend the Grand, the Day fees are retained in the M.S.T.A treasury and awarded at the following year's state shoot in the following manner. The money is to be rounded down to the nearest \$500.00 and awarded as Added Money to the High All Around winners by class (AA, A, B, C, D) High Gun 50-30-20 closed to out of state shooters.

---

## **Special Trophies**

All shooters eligible to shoot for Special Trophies must advise the cashier and place their names on the lists provided on the bulletin board.

---

## **Declare Special Categories**

All Chair Shooters, Lady I, Lady II, Juniors, Junior Gold, Sub-Juniors, Sub-Veterans, Veterans, and Senior Veterans must declare their special category at the time of their entry in any registered event. Without such a declaration at the time of entry, the shooter will not be allowed to compete for the applicable special category trophies. No exceptions to this rule are to be allowed.

---

## **Trap and Field**

The MSTA will give Champion and Runner-Up of the four ATA Championship Events a one year subscription to Trap and Field magazine. The winners must contact the MSTA secretary.

---

## **Resident**

He or she must have met the legal and Amateur Trapshooting Association requirements for citizenship in the State of Montana. He may not have participated in the state shoot for any other state, representing himself as a resident of that state and eligible for state shooting titles of that state, within the calendar year last preceding the Montana State Trapshooting Association's last state trapshoot. If he is desirous of transferring his membership from any other state to Montana and becoming a member of this Association, he shall inform the MSTA of his intentions at least six months prior to any Montana state shoot to eligible to participate in same. A shooter without a permanent Amateur Trapshooting Association card shall be required to qualify his residency with the Montana State Trapshooting Association delegate or the handicap committee

---

## **High Gun Payoffs**

The number of pays in a High Gun Payoff is determined by how many shooters enter the event. In the Montana State Shoot, one place will be paid for each quantity filled and a place for any fraction thereof. In a 1-in-7 event, one place is paid for each seven entries and one more place is paid if there are any remaining entries. For example: 21 entries pay three places, 22 entries pay four places. Four places are paid until there are 29 entries..

## General Information

- All targets will be registered with the ATA and shooters must be ATA members.
- ATA and MSTA fees apply to each day's program or event. ATA rules shall govern.
- All ties for trophies will be shot off the day the event is finished, time permitting. Failure to be present for a shoot-off will forfeit your right therein. Money will be divided in case of ties, except the Butte Medal.
- Singles shoot-offs will be limited to 100 targets, and if still tied will be carried over.
- Ties will be shot off in the following manner: Singles 25, 16-yard targets; Handicap – 25 targets; Doubles – 10 pairs; All-Around – 20 singles; 10 Handicap and 5 pair doubles.
- Please be ready when your squad is posted on the starting board.
- Hand loads permitted, subject to inspection for shot and powder specifications.
- If you want your empty cases, please catch them before they hit the ground.
- Watch your scores. They cannot be changed after you leave the shooting post.
- Errors in scores must be corrected on the score sheets before you change stations. The management will refuse to enter into discussion on this point and will compile the scores as shown on the score sheets.
- Grievances will be handled by a committee of three on the grounds.
- This is an Invitational Tournament and the management reserves the right to reject, refund, or disqualify any contestant who interferes with the safety, conduct, accuracy, or sportsmanship of the Shoot. The management may exercise the right to change or modify this program in whole or in part.
- The Handicap Committee reserves the right to change the classification of any shooter at any time during the tournament.
- On singles and handicap, only the "lost" targets will be called. In doubles, the results on both targets will be called.
- Practice traps will be open all day from 8:00 a.m. Standard brand shells will be available.
- The Missoula Trap and Skeet Club will not be responsible for any accident or for loss of property.
- The Management will disqualify any shooter who has alcoholic beverages in his possession on the firing line. See ATA Rule.
- To win the H.R. "Firecracker" Peterson 100 straight pin, you must break 100 targets in one of the three championship events (Doubles, Singles, Handicap), no carry-overs. If you qualify, see Sue or Rick Dorr..

## LEWIS B. HILL



Christmas 1971, Dorothy Hill bought her husband, Lewey Hill an Ithaca 12 gauge shotgun. That got him started in the game of trap shooting. The gun had a flaw so his friend got him lined out with a 101 Winchester over and under.

Lewey was so good at shooting that he won the Handicap State Championship in 1972, shooting 94 of 100 targets thrown. He won the Doubles State Championship in 1984, shooting 98 of 100 targets thrown. His winnings over the years saw him win the Montana State Senior Vet Championship in 1997 with 192 of 200 targets; 1998 with 193 of 200 targets; and again in 2001 with 191 of 200. He was inducted into the Montana Trap Shooters Hall of Fame in 1998.

Born and raised in Montana, Lewey enjoyed our great sport as well as experiencing outdoor life as a rancher, farmer, hunter and fisherman. He and Dorothy raised their family of three children to enjoy and thrive in our great state. He was proud of his accomplishments and humbly talks of his time in the United States Army during which time he was a member of General MacArthur's Honor Guard.

Lewey's son Scott wrote a beautiful tribute to his dad from which I will borrow some of his words:

"Lewis B. Hill has lived to be known by a variety of titles and talents. Over the years some of these would include: student, athlete, horseman, Honor Guard member, electronics wizard, rancher, innovative farmer, cattleman, water board member, bowler and Montana Hall of Fame Trap Shooter. He is respected by members of many western Montana communities for his service and honorable dealings. More importantly, he has been a loving husband (for 70 years now) and a great father of three."

Missoula Trap and Skeet Club is proud of Lewey Hill and we are glad to know him.

- He placed many times on the U.S.A. Shooting Team at the national championships.
- At the age of 50, in the U.S. Team, Jim won a country slot in the Olympic Games for the U.S. by placing tied for third in the World Cup tournament.

## **Service to the Shooting Sports**



Jim worked every Missoula state shoot and every Ron Hoppe Memorial shoot from the time he was discharged from the army until his death. For 12 years he served as the head of the U.S. Army Reserve International Trapshooting Team. He recruited team members, organized and implemented training programs that resulted in world record scores and an Olympic gold medal in International Trap (1976 Don Haldeman). He was the driving force to build an international bunker at the Missoula Trap and Skeet Club. He ran bunker practice shooting and registered tournaments until his death.
