7/8 ounce loads required in Class AA only.

Shooters will be expected to perform duties as flankers and referees.

JAMES MACK CLAWSON

James Mack Clawson, a Missoula native, died unexpectedly on Thursday, January 31, 2013, at the Age of 64. Jim began shooting when he was 10 years old and remained an avid gun advocate until the time of his death. Commissioned as a 2nd Lieutenant in the Army in 1970, he spent two years at Fort Benning, Georgia, competing for the U.S. Army International Trapshooting Team. He then went on to serve 12 years as the head of the U.S. Army Reserve International Trapshooting Team, competing in various national and international events. In the early 1980s, Jim founded MISA (Missoula International Shooting Association) and built Missoula's 15-trap bunker. Jim was a gentle man of integrity, known for his humility and kindness.

He is greatly missed!
