REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

It is important to us that you have a positive experience at this shoot. We strive to make the registration, scoring, and prize accounting as error free as possible, but we make mistakes. In order to minimize the number of mistakes, we need your help. You can help the volunteers who run this shoot by completely filling out this registration form, and by checking your copy of the registration print out for accuracy. Errors should be reported to John Hightower, who is responsible for computer data entry for scoring and registration.

- For late arrivals, you must register after the first event in which you participate; and,
- You must pay the entry fees at the time of registration.

1. **Fill out this form.** You must use your class and average information from your NSSA score card. *All of the registration information is required to ensure: that we can contact you after the shoot if necessary; that the NSSA database information is correct; that you claim the correct age concurrent; and, that we can pay you if you win a prize. Please print legibly, if you can't read your entry information, neither can we.*
2. **Have the squad and squad position information added at the squadding desk.** John Hightower is in charge of squadding. He can answer most of your registration questions.
 - a. If you are not a current member of the Montana Skeet Shooting Association, pick up a membership card and stub from the squadding desk, and complete the membership information on the stub. Leave the stub and card attached. Give the card and stub to the cashier when you submit your registration form and pay the fees. We will return your MSSA card when you pick up your registration print out after your registration information is entered in the computer. The card must be signed by a MSSA officer, so this may take a while. We keep the stub for the MSSA.
 - b. If you are not a current member National Skeet Shooting Association, complete a NSSA membership application and give it to the cashier when you submit your registration.
3. **Take your completed registration form, and MSSA and NSSA forms if needed, to the cash register window and pay the fees due.** The cashier will check the total fees due and accept your payment.
4. **Pick up and review your registration print out from the cashier's window.** Make sure that your classes, averages, and event entries are correct. The registration print out will be available some time after you submit your registration and pay the fees. The print out is available only after we've entered the data from your registration form in the computer's shoot program.
