### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- 1. All participants must be current members in good standing of NSSA. The shoot will be governed by NSSA rules and regulations.
- 2. An up-to-date legible classification card will be required from every shooter. Junior and Sub-Junior shooters are permitted to complete on a "targets only" basis. All other competitors must be classified.
- 3. Registration will be open (Thursday Evening and Friday).
- 4. Squads will not be announced. Shooters are requested to be at the assigned field 15 minutes prior to the scheduled start of the flight. Management reserves the right to move slow squads to the practice field, mechanical or weather problems excepted. Field electricity will be shut off in case of electrical storm activity.
- 5. Champions and Ladies awards will be presented on the main shootoff field immediately following completion of shootoffs. All other medals and awards will be available the following day, with the exception of 410 and HOA/HAA awards. A schedule will be posted. All awards not picked up in person will be mailed within 15 business days.
- 6. All winners and payouts will be posted on the scoreboards the following day, 410, HOA and HAA excepted. All payouts will be mailed within 15 days of the shoot.
- 7. The protest committee will consist of shoot management.
- 8. Missoula Trap and Skeet reserves the right to alter or cancel any part of this program if conditions warrant. Shoot management also reserves the right to refuse any entry or cause the withdrawal of any contestant who annoys, endangers or interferes in any way with the harmony of the shoot.
- 9. Spectators and contestants assume all risks resulting from accident or loss of property occurring on gun club property. All contestants, referees and field personnel are required to wear eye and ear protection while on any shooting field. Spectators are likewise requested to wear eye protection at all times that shooting is taking place.
- 10. Campers and vendors, please reserve spaces in advance. Contact the club or go to the website to download a reservation form. We will attempt to comply with all special requests. Campers and vendors are requested to check in at the club office upon arrival to obtain site assignments.
- 11. The club will be open for practice on Thursday afternoon and during the shoot whenever possible.
- 12. The club kitchen will be open for breakfast and lunch every day, and for dinner on Saturday

### **INFORMATION**

Registration will include a 'Meal Pass' option. \$10 Lunches Only, \$20 Saturday Evening BBQ dinner only, \$25 Lunches and Saturday evening dinner.

Final payout amounts will be determined by the KUSA 2025 Shoot management team. Amounts in this program are for information only.

Optional Purses – Optional Purse, Champ of Champs, & Oklahomas are club local only and are determined by class – ties divide.

Calcutta: \$5.00 buy in. Calcutta auction will be held at the Saturday night dinner. The Calcutta will be paid out at 70/30 - 70% to buyer, 30% to the event winners.

Missoula Purse is a \$10.00 buy in. To win the Missoula Purse shooters must break the required number of targets for their class (HOA). For example: AA/AAA shooters must break 250 of 250 targets, which is composed of 3 rounds of 12 ga, 3 rounds of 20 ga, 2 rounds of 28 ga and 2 rounds of .410. Shoot administration will pick which rounds prior to the first flight of 12 ga event. If there is no winner, all money stays in the purse until the next 4 gun event at MTSC. Payout is 50% of funds in the purse + all entry fees for the current shoot.

### **SHOOT-OFFS**

Shoot-offs will be called no later than 30 minutes following the conclusion of the last flight each day and will consist of doubles miss and out by station, stations 3, 4 and 5. Shoot-offs will decide open CH, RU and 3<sup>rd</sup>, and all class places involving the return of the class purse. Concurrent events will be shot off concurrently with the championship where possible. Ties for HOA CH only will be shot off one round of singles miss and out, then doubles 3, 4, and 5, miss and out by station. It is the shooters responsibility to report to the designated shoot-off field, on time.
